FARM TRANSITION CONFERENCE SCHEDULED FOR MACON COUNTY FARMERS AND LANDOWNERS

Franklin, NC (July 31, 2013) – NC Farm Bureau Macon County and NC Cooperative Extension Macon County are partnering with Mount Olive College's Lois G. Britt Agribusiness Center to conduct a farm transition conference for area farmers and landowners on Thursday August 15, 2013. Mount Olive College received funding from the USDA Risk Management Agency to conduct farm transition regional events and workshops in North Carolina.
